**Alan Blake – Budget Airlines.** Alan is a retired pilot, who will be giving us an insight into what goes on behind the scenes of a budget airline. Most of us will have experienced use of these airlines, and we should be given some detail on the background and reasons for the various problems and frustrations some of us may have experienced?

**Cheda Panajotovic – Teaching the Unteachable.** Cheda will be talking to us about his life and experiences of teaching in an inner city school. He spent 7 years amongst his lovely ruffians who have been known to 'expel' so many teachers within a couple of days of them arriving at the school. Teacher trainers would make many a visit just to study how he 'survived'. What others found tough, he found fascinating, and he still holds extremely fond memories of 'his boys'.

**Kathryn Marsden – Diet and Digestion.** Kathryn gave a superb talk to us last year on the subjects of diet and digestion, which proved to be extremely popular with the members. She has kindly agreed to return to speak to us again in September, but on this occasion, we will be changing the format of the usual presentation. We have asked Kathryn to talk about the issues that our own members may have on this vast subject. We will be asking members to give us topics on which they have concerns, and about which they would wish Kathryn to speak, and she will do her utmost to answer whatever queries are raised.

**Chris Duffin – Life as a Prison Governor.** Unfortunately, due to illness, Chris was unable to give her talk on this subject in February, but has kindly agreed to give her presentation at the October meeting.
